Annual Conference

The Annual conference will run **Tuesday, Aug. 5 and Wednesday, Aug. 6**. Delegate registraion is **\$450** each (postmarked by 7/25) or \$475 each after. Non-Member Registration is **\$615** each (postmarked by 7/25) or \$640 each after.

Institute of Government

SCAC will offer Institute of Government for County Officials Level I, Level II and Advanced Classes on **Monday, Aug. 4 and Tuesday, Aug. 5**. All **classes are \$90** each (postmarked by 7/25) or \$100 each after.

Participants who have the credits to graduate from Level I or Level II will be recognized during the General Session on Wednesday, Aug. 6.

Registration and Wild Dunes Reservation Process

SCAC must receive a completed registration before the Wild Dunes Resort reservation link will be sent. You must be a paid registrant to receive the discounted hotel rate.

Institute of Government registrants will receive the reservation link via email within two business days of receipt of completed registration.

Those registering **only for the Annual Conference** will receive the Wild Dunes Resort reservation information the **second week in April** or within two business days if their registration is received on or after **April** 7.
